We love having visitors at Roskruge. If you are interested in visiting or becoming a volunteer, please contact the front office at 520-225-2900. All visitors are required to sign in at the front office and get a visitor's tag, even if you will only be on campus for a short time.

Additional Reminders

*Morning Drop-Off:

Students may be on campus at 7:45 am. Please do not drop off your student before that as there is no supervision before that time.

Please do not park in the staff parking lot to drop of your students. It is dangerous with so many cars coming in and we are also having issue with staff being able to find parking. If you cannot find a parking space, please drop off your student in the student drop off area on the northeast corner of the school. Make sure they have their backpacks and water bottles ready to get down quickly. This is a no parking zone.

*Parent Pick-Up/Dismissal:

Dismissal for elementary students is 3:03 pm and 3:50 pm for middle school students. Please make arrangements to pick up your student on time. We do not have additional supervision for childcare after those times. We also cannot let students leave to the tiendita then return to campus to be picked up. Once students are off campus they cannot return.

Elementary Parents- please wait for your students outside and the teacher or teacher's aide will escort the students out of the building. Please do not pick up your student in the hallway as the teacher may not see where or who they are going with.

Middle School Parents-please Park to pick up your students. We cannot have students running to the middle of the street to get in cars. It is a safety concern because of cars backing out. If you would prefer to your child to walk and meet you somewhere down the road, please remind them to use the crosswalks on the West and East sides of the school.

Students Staying for Games: Any student that would like to stay to watch a sports game must have a parent with them. We do not have additional supervision for students that want to stay late for games.
