Hello Roskruge Families,

Welcome to the 23-24 school year! We are so happy to meet our new students and see our returning students. School starts on Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> and here is some information to help you get through the first couple of days.

## School start/end times: First bell rings at 8:48

- o 8:48 a.m. 3:03 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday (2:03 p.m. Wednesday) Elementary
- o 8:48 a.m. 3:50 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday (2:50 p.m. Wednesday) Middle School

## Student Drop-Off & Pick-Up

- We have minimal parking at Roskruge so we encourage parents to use the drop-off lane on the northeast corner of the school. Please remember to have kids exit the car on the passenger side and have all their belongings ready so they can exit the car quickly. This lane is for quick drop off so please pull as far forward as possible, stay in your car, and let your child down quickly. If your child needs help getting their backpack on or getting down, please park in a designated parking space. Do not park in the drop off lane.
- Please Park and get down to pick up their elementary students. At the end of the day teacher will escort their students outside to the front steps on the north side of the school. You will pick up your student from the teacher, so they know who the child is going home with. I know the parking situation at Roskruge is not ideal, thank you for your patience. Middle school parents will also park, and students will be released to their cars.
- Please do not stop in the middle of the street to drop-off or pick-up your students. Also, students that
  walk will need to walk to the corners on the north sides of the school to cross the street. This is for
  everyone's safety so please be considerate of these expectations.
- The parking lot on the east side of the school is for Roskruge Staff. Please do not park in this area or pull in to let your child into the cafeteria. \*\*\*We will have this parking lot open to parents for the first two days of school only as we know those days have more traffic. \*\*\*
- o If it rains, we ask that elementary parents please get down to pick up your student/s from their classroom.
- Student schedules for middle school will be available in ParentVue and StudentVue on August 1<sup>st</sup>. We will have printed schedules available in the morning on the first day of school however if you are able to print the schedule at home it will allow your child to avoid waiting in a long line.
- You are welcome to tour the building on Wednesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> between the hours 9 am- 1 pm. The teachers and other staff will not be available to meet because they will be preparing for the first day of school, however you are welcome to familiarize yourself with the location of your child's class.

Breakfast/Lunch is no longer free for all students. Each Roskruge Family must apply for free or reduced meals
unless a student is receiving SNAP, TANF, in the foster-care system or McKinney-Vento program as they
automatically qualify for free meal benefits. Apply for Free/Reduced Meal Benefits Now: Free and Reduced
