Mrs. Carranza **moves** to approve the October 28, 2024 meeting minutes; Mrs. Padilla seconds the motion; there being no objection, the minutes are approved as submitted.

President's report

- 1) Peter Piper Pizza fundraiser earned \$290.15.
- 2) The Winter Street Fair is December 13, 14, and 15, 2024. Dale Lopez will create a sign up sheet for parents and teachers. Mrs. Carranza will continue to announce the event in the Noticiero. The parking fee will be \$10. Ms. Fugli has street signs.
- 3) The curb bumper issue will also be resolved before the Fair. Mrs. Padilla found bumpers on Amazon which can be ordered if necessary.

UPDATE: Mrs. Padilla and Mr. Gomez spoke (after the meeting) and he has a person working on metal portable curb bumpers which will be ready by Fair time. The cost is around \$400.

- 5) The Scholastic Book Fair is the week of December 16-19, 2024. We are still looking for volunteers to help as TUSD employees are not permitted to manage money. Employees can assist with all other book fair responsibilities.

New Business

Mrs. Grunloh **moves**, on behalf of Mrs. Hoffman that monies be allocated for Roskruge needy families. There are five families and ten children who have been identified. Mrs. Carranza seconds the motion. There being no objection, \$400.00 from the General Fund will be given to Mrs. Hoffman to provide for the five families and their children.

Mrs. Fletcher asks if she and Mrs. Murrieta can be reimbursed for purchases made as incentives for students during the family life studies. Mrs. Carranza **moves** that they be reimbursed out of the Stacy Redondo Memorial Fund. Mr. Lopez seconds the motion. There being no discussion, Mrs. Fletcher and Mrs. Murrieta are asked to submit their receipts to the treasurer. Update the total paid out is \$137.20

Mrs. Padilla states that parents have been asking her how they can be made aware of sports events. Mrs. Carrana states that this information is always in the Noticiero. Mr. Lopez states that the Roskruge website can be updated to include a "sports button." Dale Lopez will look into adding information to the website.

Mrs. Padilla asked Mrs. Carranza to use ParentLink to invite all 4th grade students to a Posadas Party at the Rivera family home. There will be Karaoke, a DJ, food, and crafts. Please join Elisa Rivera for this holiday celebration which could become a Roskruge tradition.
