II. Call to order: The meeting was called to order at 5:32pm.

III. Approve minutes from 3/23/2026 meeting: The meeting minutes were posted to the Roskruge website. Ms. Fletcher moved to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Padilla Rivera. There was no discussion and the motion passed.

IV. Reports:

President’s Report

Ms. Padilla Rivera reported that PTA’s fundraising night at Peter Piper Pizza on April 16th raised \$250.56. This was the last Peter Piper night of the school year.

Vice President’s report

Treasurer’s Report

- Ms. Bly emailed the Treasurer’s report prior to the meeting. The beginning balance was \$59,921.09. Total expenses were \$23,243.80. Total deposits were \$14,028.98. The ending balance was \$50,706.27.

Principal’s Report

Mrs. Carranza reported that

- Noche de Gala was successful. Changes for next year will include posting a sign informing attendees that tickets are non-refundable and adding a second floodlight. PTA will work on getting a better QR code for the events and the permits from PCHD.
- Noche de Estrellas was well attended. Ms. Cintron gave seventh-grade students extra credit for bringing family members and demonstrating how to use microscopes. The Tucson Ghostbusters were a big hit.
- Track, softball, and kickball are underway.
- Logramos and iReady testing are underway.
- Ms. Silva Cereceres and Mr. Olivas attended the Magnet Schools of America national conference in San Diego, where they accepted Roskruge’s Magnet School of Excellence Award.
- April 28th will be popsicle day. Every student who arrived to school on time during the AASA writing test will receive a popsicle.
- Puma Day and Menudo Bowl will be on May 15th.
- The UA Poetry Center published a book containing students’ poetry.

- Mariachi Pumas will perform Wednesday, April 29th at the MSA Annex.
- Menudo Bowl/Puma Day will be May 15th.

V. Old Business:

- Roskruge Hall of Fame- Mr. De Leon submitted a letter nominating Jesus Urriarte (Chuy) to the Hall of Fame. Mr. Lopez read the letter aloud. Ms. Bly made a motion to induct Chuy and Heriberto Martinez to the Hall of Fame, which was seconded by Ms. Carranza. The motion passed unanimously.
- Corner Store/Ward 6 Letter- Ms. Fletcher shared that the issues at the corner store are ongoing. Staff are in the process of coordinating a visit from Councilmember Miranda Schubert.
- Walkie-talkies for future parking events- tabled.

VI. New Business:

- Ms. Corrales requested that PTA purchase Eegees for Dia de los Ninos. Ms. Padilla moved that PTA spend up to \$50.00 to purchase the Eegees. Ms. Fletcher seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- PTA Standing Rules- Ms. Bly amended the original motion to state that if ratified, the proposed standing rules would take effect in the 2026-2027 school year. Ms. Carranza moved to vote on the proposed amendments. Her motion was seconded by Ms. Grunloh. During discussion, Ms. Carranza noted that Arizona PTA recommended that for tax purposes, all clubs that fundraise through PTA should have at least one PTA member in good standing. The cost to join PTA is \$8.00. To address any hardships, clubs may pay PTA directly out of fundraising activities or make payments of \$1.00 throughout the year. The motion passed unanimously and will go into effect next school year.
 - 1) *Amend the local PTA Standing Rules to require that at least one person managing each club and/or classroom be a member in good standing of the local PTA, aka Roskruge Magnet School PTA.*
 - 2) *Amend the local PTA Standing Rules to specify that only members in good standing may request to inspect the internal documents of the PTA, i.e. the treasurer's full monthly report.*

VIII. Call to Audience

- Ms. Carranza thanked PTA for everything they do for the school.
- Mr. Lopez reminded members that PTA will need people to volunteer for parking cars for THS graduation. Mr. Lopez will send out information.
- Ms. Perez asked why Roskruge doesn't have benches on the basketball court. Mr. Lopez shared that there are moveable benches that can be brought out during games and put away when the courts are used for other purposes.
