**II. Call to order:** Meeting called to order at 5:40pm.**III. Approve minutes from 10/27/2025 meeting:** The meeting minutes were posted to the Roskruge website. Mr. Lopez moved to approve the minutes. His motion was seconded by Mrs. Bly. There was no discussion and the motion passed.**IV. Reports:**

## President's Report

- Ms. Padilla reported that the joint fundraiser at Peter Piper Pizza on Silverbell was a success. The outcome was better than at the 12<sup>th</sup> and Ajo location. The school received \$298.99, which will be split evenly with the mariachi club.

## Vice President's report

- The School Store update was provided during Old Business.

## Treasurer's Report

- Ms. Bly reported that the PTA account has a balance of \$41,689.09. The general fund balance is \$973.23.

## Principal's Report

Mrs. Carranza reported that

- 50 student teachers and 6 professors from Sonora, Mexico visited Roskruge to observe our dual-language program.
- Roskruge hosted a GLAD training for teachers.
- AZ Luminaria visited Roskruge for an upcoming feature on bilingual education.
- Roskruge participated in two magnet events in November, one at Tucson Children's Museum and another at Tucson High.
- Mariachi and folklorico will perform on December 16<sup>th</sup>.
- Roskruge's letter grade dropped to a C. Excessive absences were a factor in our score.

- PBIS is going well. Middle school students have earned pizza with the principal, ice cream with the principal, and other prizes. MS teachers are inviting students who demonstrate positive behavior to a monthly donuts and milk celebration.
- MS students are studying Family Life Curriculum.
- December 5<sup>th</sup> is Penguin Patch Holiday Shop and Santa photos.
- Mariachi will have a fundraiser at Peter Piper Pizza on 12<sup>th</sup> and Ajo on December 8<sup>th</sup>.
- The Student of the Quarter assembly will be on December 9<sup>th</sup>.
- Sign-up for Street Fair parking will begin on Monday, December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- TUSD governing board approved a compensation update for 2025-2026, which includes a one-time payment of \$1,200 for all classifications.
- A Roskruge 3<sup>rd</sup> grader placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 42<sup>nd</sup> annual Roskruge Cross Country Cougar Classic.

**V. Old Business: -**

- Bumper stickers- Mrs. Fletcher shared that the bumper stickers will be available for sale in the front office. The stickers were purchased at a cost of \$1.70 and will be sold for \$3.00. This will allow us to advertise our school as we drive around town.
- Roskruge Hall of Fame- The item was tabled.
- Penguin Patch Holiday store- The holiday store is scheduled for one day, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Mrs. Bly and Mrs. Padilla will set up the store the day before. Mrs. Padilla will run the store day of. We need a cash box and \$50 seed money for the store. Ms. Fletcher has an extra cash box.
- School Store Fundraiser- over 400 gift cards have been sent to teachers totaling over \$4,000.

**VI. New Business:**

- Trekking Mexico Field Trip- Ms. Grunloh requested PTA help cover the cost of the fieldtrip to see Trekking Mexcio. Roskruge Site Council has agreed to pay a portion of the cost but requested that Ms. Grunloh ask PTA as well. Students will be asked to pay \$3.00 to attend the field trip. As the PTA general fund has a balance of \$973.23, members advised that Ms. Grunloh request the funds after the December street fair fundraiser.
- Roskruge staff holiday gathering- Mr. Lopez moved that PTA use \$600.00 to cater the holiday gathering at Ms. Perez's house. Mrs. Bly seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
- Street Fair Parking- 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Street Fair is December 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup>. Proceeds from December 12<sup>th</sup> will go directly to PTA. Mr. Lopez will be able to help until 2:00pm. Mrs. Bly will arrive at 12:30pm. PTA will ask Mr. Roberts to create a QR code for cashless payments.
- Thank you for Vineyard and UCity- Ms. Hoffman shared that both churches are helping students families over the holidays. Instead of providing cookies to the congregations, PTA will ask mariachi and folklorico groups to perform as a thank you for their help.

**VIII. Call to Audience**

- Ms. Fletcher purchased snacks for Family Life Curriculum. She will email Mrs. Bly and PTA will reimburse her purchase of \$215.00.
